### Fish Limits

Fish size: Walleye 14 inches and over.

DNR permit NO sauger will be weighed.

Each boat is allowed to weigh a limit of five (5) fish, per day. When your 6th fish goes into the live well you are done fishing for the day. Release any fish not being weighed prior to making your final run in. **Culling is not allowed.** 

Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish. An 8-ounce deduction will be made for each fish presented to the bump master for weighing that is determined to be non-releasable.

#### **Required Safety Equipment**

It is the responsibility of all anglers to have required state and federal safety equipment on board.

At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to display 1 Chest type life jacket for each angler; 1 throwable PFD; and, demonstrate functioning kill switch.

Inspection will be held during lineup for takeoff. Live wells must be empty.

Keep marine band radios on Channel 72 for tournament information and use Channel 16 for emergencies.

#### **Boundaries**

The tournament waters for this event shall be Lake Winnebago, also Fox River, Lake Butte Des Mort, Lake Poygan, Lake Winneconne, Wolf River. Any waters within these boundaries posted "off limits" or "no fishing" by state or federal agencies will be off limit. Any live release areas established by the Tournament director will be off limits. That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at the pre-tournament briefing. Only water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All local, state
